### MISSION BEACH & SURROUNDS

With its golden palm-fringed beaches and the clear blue waters of the Coral Sea, and perfect tropical islands close enough to paddle to, Mission Beach looks like a picture from a postcard. Mission Beach encompasses four charming villages: South Mission Beach, Wongaling Beach, Mission Beach, and Bingil Bay – each offering a distinctive coastal experience.

Explore the wonders of the Great Barrier Reef. Check out vibrant local markets and savour superb local food produce. Thrill-seekers can try white-water rafting, skydiving, and mountain biking. Experience world-renowned fishing or immerse yourself in lively festivals and events – all set against tropical rainforest and stunning beachfront scenery.

### BINGIL BAY

Bingil Bay offers a serene tropical escape, full of laidback charm. The quaint village centres around the funky Bingil Bay Café. Only 10 minutes' drive away is the enchanting Lacey Creek. The 1.5km creek walk has great interpretive signage and a beautiful rainforest stream. Lacey Creek is a freshwater oasis teeming with wildlife and away from the crowds.

### MISSION BEACH

Mission Beach has absolute beachfront accommodation in a village atmosphere. Enjoy charming boutiques, quaint cafes, nice restaurants, and a friendly Visitor Information Centre. Visit Clump Point Jetty for breathtaking views and excellent fishing. Embark on the family-friendly Ulysses Walk which follows the beachfront. Jump on a Reef, Island or Boat charter from the Marina. Discover why Mission Beach holiday makers keep returning, year after year.

### WONGALING BEACH

A few kilometres south of Mission Beach is the equally beautiful Wongaling Beach. Wongaling has a modern shopping centre, several cafes, boutique specialty shops, and a picturesque picnic area overlooking the sea. The kids will love the free splash pad. Use Wongaling as a base for exploring the pristine Djiru National Park, or the world-famous Dunk Island.

### SOUTH MISSION BEACH

Stunning South Mission Beach has the best of the Coral Sea and the coastal wetlands. It's a great beach for swimming and backs on to the estuarine mangroves and swamp forest of the sprawling Hull River National Park. From here you can explore the Kennedy Track.

- Largest concentration of the endangered cassowary in Australia
- Bordered by the two World Heritage-listed sites of Great Barrier Reef and the Wet Tropics rainforest
- The name Mission Beach is a misnomer, due to a local Aboriginal settlement that was mistakenly thought to be a mission
- Closest access point to the Great Barrier Reef
- Birthplace of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park
