

Ponytail Falls, Tully Gorge National Park

Right in the heart of Tropical North Queensland is Tully, a town known for its rich history and extraordinary landscapes. The Tully Visitor and Heritage Centre serves as a gateway to this captivating town. Tours of the historic Tully Sugar Mill, offering a fascinating glimpse into the sugar production process, can be booked here during harvesting season. The iconic Golden Gumboot, an oversized monument (8 metres) celebrating the town's prodigious rainfall, is a quirky must-see.

## FAST FACTS

- Average annual rainfall in Tully is 4,116mm.
- Highest rainfall recorded in Tully is 7,900mm in 1950.
- Highest daily rainfall in Tully ever recorded is 1,140mm.
- Average number of days of rainfall each year is 150 days.
- Tully Sugar Mill was erected in 1924.
- Tully township was established in 1924.
- Home of the Tully Tigers Leagues Club.
- Home of the Golden Gumboot.
- Home of The Australian Army's Combat Training Centre – Jungle Training Wing (CTC-JTW).
- Mount Tyson (687m) overlooks the township of Tully.
- In 1935, a hydro electric power station was built in the Tully Gorge which is a major provider of electricity for the cities of Cairns and Townsville.
- 90% of Australia's bananas are produced in the Tully/Innisfail area.
